Zambia is home of the Victoria Falls and many other magnificent waterfalls, spectacular wildlife, superb safaris, great adventures, rich culture and friendly people.

Zambia is acknowledged as one of the safest countries in the world to visit, it's people live in peace and harmony.

Described as 'Mosi-oa-Tunya' by the 'Kololo tribe' in the 1800's - 'the Smoke that Thunders' and in more modern terms as 'the greatest known curtain of falling water', Victoria Falls are a spectacular sight of awe-inspiring beauty and grandeur on the Zambezi River, bordering Zambia and Zimbabwe.

Columns of spray can be seen from miles away as 546 million cubic metres of water per minute plummet over the edge. There is a path along the edge of the forest for those brave enough, to feel the tremendous spray with an unparalleled series of views of the Falls.

Blessed with lush vegetation, abundant water and a real commitment to preserving her wilderness, Zambia has maintained it's untouched aura to this day. A truly magical country.

Botswana has dedicated almost 30% of its land to conservation. The Okavango Delta, Kalahari Desert, Makgadigadi Salt Pans and the lush Linyanti regions are just a few wildlife areas to explore.

With few visitors, some of Africa's best wildlife viewing and an efficient infrastructure, the country is easy to explore by small plane, 4x4 vehicle or on a mobile camping safari. It is one of Africa's most stable countries.

Zambezi Horseback Safaris - Zimbabwe & Zambia

Canter through the bush or stand unnoticed watching small game such as bushbuck and duiker. All trails are led by experienced rider guides and all riding levels are catered for. A first aid box and radio accompanies each trail.

Full day Chobe excursion - Zimbabwe & Zambia

The Chobe National park in Botswana is easily accessible from Victoria Falls and Livingstone. The safari begins with a cruise on the Chobe River and is followed by an afternoon game drive. The big cats and large herds of elephant, abundant general game and prolific bird life make this full day excursion worthwhile.

Game Drives And Walking Safaris - Zimbabwe & Zambia

Guided game drives in open safari vehicles are operated in the morning and late afternoons. As well as numerous bird species game that may be seen includes elephant, buffalo, giraffe, zebra, waterbuck, and other antelope. Specialised Rhino Safaris are available in the Musi-oo-Tunya National Park. Travelling on foot is the best way to experience the African bush and the walking safaris in the Zambezi National Park are accompanied by a professional guide who is able to explain the bush ecosystem including spoor tracking and the surrounding fauna.
